Monkton Stadium, Jarrow Monday 19th July

After a 5 week break, the Vets' Track & Field titanic battle for supremacy between Crook and South Shields resumed, although for those of us who did the Coastal Run the day before, the timing could have been better! On a wet but mild night, Crook fielded a 9 strong squad, with the absence of Mike Mallen, Dave Welsh, Alan Welsh, and Allan Purdham being partly offset by first appearances in 2010 for Jason Alison and Mike Simpson. The return of the talismatic Percy Parkin from injury was also a welcome bonus!

Our points tally on the night was a highly respectable 128 (averaging 14.2 per person out of a maximum of 18), but South Shields were again out in force and amassed an enormous 185 points. This proved enough to overhaul our 41 point lead and the positions at the top of the league are now as follows:
